Navigating the species – Timber Cladding

Different species of timber will behave slightly differently and there will be one type that is most suited to any given building project. Canadian Western Red Cedar and Siberian Larch are very popular species for timber cladding.

These species don't require preservative treatment and provide a sustainable material that lasts the test of time.

For a more colour stable option, NORclad offer a Koppers treatment, MicroShades 'Brunnea', containing UV inhibitors and pigment within the treatment.

Once you've decided on a timber species, you have further options on how the timber will appear; contemporary designs often use PSE boards, or T&G cladding, replacing the more traditional featheredge or shiplap profiles people may be familiar with.
